

CE1 - CORE ESSENTIALS – IPL & Laser Certification

NZ Laser Training believes that trainees who are new to IPL or Laser should start with hair removal before moving into skin rejuvenation due to the higher level of risk associated with inadvertently treating over skin cancers or early stage undiagnosed melanoma's. It is for this reason we focus more on hair removal at this level of learning, with some introductory overview into skin rejuvenation. Past trainees have enjoyed and appreciated that the course provides a good taster of both applications, using both modalities (IPL & Laser), so they can then go on to decide which avenue they may wish to choose for further study. This course is ideal as a supplement for those seeking to go into Laser Tattoo removal as they will gain extra confidence in laser safety, laser science and competency handling a laser in general, (please note we don't use the tattoo removal laser on this course however handling an Nd:yag hair removal laser means you can get used to firing a laser.)

FAQ's: PLEASE READ

Will I be certified? YES, certified means being issued a certificate. NZ Laser Training certificates are only issued to trainees who meet the course minimum requirements which includes an 80% minimum pass mark on the online assessment. One re-sit is permitted at no charge to the trainee, however if trainees do not pass this re-sit they would be required to reapply and re-attend the course to obtain the level of comprehension required to obtain the pass mark and therefore the certificate. We will work with individuals needs on a case by case basis.



Is there any pre-course reading material or pre- study required?

Yes, an online pre-course module which steps out some basic principles and information to prepare trainees for the course content is provided on receipt of full course payment. It is up to the trainee to process, and read through this valuable preview prior to attending the course. The cost of this resource is included in the course fee. **Access to this online pre-course content is available until the Friday following your CE1 course date.**

Although no pre-requisite applies to the CE1 training course, it would be an advantage to have basic hair and skin anatomy knowledge as well as an overview on the hair growth cycle. If you already have a laser or IPL machine, it would also be useful to have information on the specifications of the device so the learning can be applied to your device. Additional skin and hair anatomy and physiology education may be obtained through attending a Beauty Training school who specialise in this type of training. NZ Laser Training Courses provide an overview for the purposes of treating hair and skin with IPL / Laser, however our focus is on IPL & Laser science and safe application of the devices.

Do I need to be a beauty therapist (or other qualification relating to this industry) to attend this course?

No, this is an open entry but comprehensive course.

Completing our Online Laser Safety Course (LSC) is recommended but currently not a requirement.

We believe every operator of IPL and Laser should also be educated in medical grade skin lesion information and awareness, so we strongly advise also attending our "Skin Cancers, Lesions and Melanoma workshop with Dr Chris Dickey".

What pathway options exist for me after this training course? (Our recommendations)

- Work for a beauty therapy or appearance medicine clinic and operate the IPL or hair removal laser under supervision
- Start an IPL or Laser clinic of your own – conducting basic hair removal – continue training with NZ Laser Training to gain more knowledge and skills to expand your offerings as your experience and skillset increases. (CE2)
- Add IPL or Laser hair removal to your existing treatment menu in the clinic
- Continue your learning with us and complete the full suite of courses and workshops to gain a range of Certification for a nationally, industry recognised certificates in IPL & Laser

Will this course be Internationally recognised?

Each country has different regulations, licensing requirements and therefore even within the same country the requirements differ between states. Recognition of prior learning can be applied for using your letter of attainment and a copy of your certificate. This is standard practice within the industry as each training provider may vary what is offered. If you are planning on working in Australia, you will be able to apply to Queensland Radiation (Email: Radiation_Health@health.qld.gov.au) for assessment to apply for a laser license which is not required here in New Zealand. This licence is only required if you plan to work in Queensland, Australia. Learning obtained with NZ Laser Training is generic in nature and applies to all lasers and IPL devices worldwide so this course provides a foundation in which to up-skill from.
